Release the mic and wait for the net control to acknowledge your check in. We will take several check-ins before acknowledging them. We will not be asking whether you are in or out for tonight's net as we will not be calling individuals by call sign for traffic.
After everyone has checked in we will give any timely MARA announcements that need to be shared and then we will play the ARRL Audio News for this week. Following the Audio News we will open the net for general sharing including information on any general operating opportunities and contests coming up, bragging, accomplishments, questions and other information participants would like to share.
